HOW TO DRILL YOUR CUTTING BOARD

THINGS YOU'LL NEED:

- A drill
- 1/2" drill bit (this will give some play)
- A clamp
- Marker
- Safety goggles

STEPS:

1. Put on goggles

- 2. If your old board's holes do not go all the way through the board, use a $\frac{1}{2}$ " drill bit and finish drilling them all the way through the old board.
- 3. Place your new board on a flat surface, with a flat scrap block underneath that you can drill into.
- 4. Place the old board on top of the new board and align, if the new board is larger make sure you align accordingly.
- 5. When you have them aligned, mark both holes(this will help you align after the first hole) use the clamp to clamp them together, as soon as you make a starter hole, you can move the old board out of the way while you finish.
- 6. Align the holes again and repeat for the second hole.
- 7. Sanitize your new board and enjoy.
